Leadership Opportunities

Troop is small (just reorganized in 1999), scouts range in age from 11-16, and in rank from Scout to Eagle. Troop requests that at least one parent from each Scout family to be a registered leader and to attend monthly Troop Committee meetings. Our annual planning meeting gives all Troop members an opportunity to share in the year's plan. Junior Leader training is conducted early in each term of office and we have an active Patrol Leader Council. Troop Junior Leaders have participated in the Council's Pine Tree Training, and served on staff. We have Scouts and Adult Leaders active in the Order of the Arrow. Scouts and Adult Leaders have attended Council training and have served as staff in District and Council activities. We follow National Guidelines for advancement and the last four years have been Quality Unit and Trailblazer.

Highlights of Yearly Activities

Troop 646 is a 12 month, year-round camping troop. Our annual Spring Break trips have included Washington, DC; Niagara Falls, Canada; D-Day Museum and Aquarium in New Orleans, LA; Mobile, AL to sleep aboard the USS Alabama battleship and the Grand Canyon.
