Leadership Opportunities

Opportunities for all positions; any boy or adult who joins the Troop is encouraged to be a leader. Elected positions: Senior Patrol Leader and Patrol Leaders. All other youth leadership positions appointed by the SPL and/or Scoutmaster after submitting an application. The typical term of office is 6 months. Junior Leader Training is held after each election.

Assistant Scoutmaster, Committee Positions, and Merit Badge Counselors are available for all adults and participation is strongly encouraged and needed. The boys need and deserve our support.

Highlights of Yearly Activities

We offer a full Scouting program.

We camp once a month, usually on third weekend of the month.

Some traditional outings have been: Trapper Rendezvous - Snow Skiing – Family Float Trip - Thanksgiving Family Campout.

Annual Summer Camp at Hale Scout Reservation

In 2005 we had one crew hike Philmont and another canoe Boundary Waters.

Other outings this past year have included the OKC Rock Gym, the Kansas Cosmosphere & Space Center, and a Civil War Battle Reenactment.

We offer a skills night once a month with a focus towards that month's Camp-out. Merit Badge Classes are offered at many scout meetings, with an emphasis towards their need for advancement and/or are their special interest.

Other Information:

Troop has one trailer.

Financial Position – each scout pays \$50 per year in dues for equipment and awards. Typical campout costs are normally \$10/scout. Special events like skiing cost more. Our primary fundraiser is through Popcorn Sales, which funds the boys' scout accounts.

A number of registered leaders have completed Woodbadge and BSLT training, plus other specialized training. We welcome parents of scouts to become registered leaders and to be active in the troop, at meetings and outings.
