Leadership Opportunities

Troop 920 is a boy led troop with two active patrols. Elections for senior patrol leader and patrol leader are held bi-annually. The new leaders appoint the assistant patrol leader, quartermaster, scribe, Chaplain and other positions as needed. Elections are followed by leadership training sessions. The small size of the Troop allows for considerable opportunity for each boy to gain experience at the various positions.

Adults are encouraged to become active in the Troop and become trained in their areas of interest. Troop 920 currently has adults trained in archery, shooting, climbing and repelling and first-aid. Some members have attended Wood Badge.
